Background

Caring for China was established to provide love and care for abandoned and orphaned babies and children in China. Since 1994 over 400 abandoned children have been welcomed into our three childcare centers in Central China where they have received love, care, medical treatment, therapy and education. Some are now being placed in local Chinese foster families.

We work in association with the government-run welfare system, under the jurisdiction of the Provincial Civil Affairs Bureau and Municipal Governments. Three Chinese welfare centers have invited us to staff and manage childcare centers in buildings or facilities allocated to us:

- **Hephzibah** ("My Delight is in Her") is located on the top floor of a magnificent new building.
- **Shekinah Shalom** ("Radiant Glory and Peace") fills a 3-story building surrounded by extensive grounds in a beautiful rural setting.
- **Hope Haven** occupies the ground floor of an existing welfare center.

Children

Many of our children are girls with normal needs. Additionally, many children in our care, both girls and boys, have a wide range of special needs and disabilities. Usually babies and young children with normal or minor special needs will be adopted. *Caring for China* is committed to providing on-going long-term care for children who are not adopted.



Staff

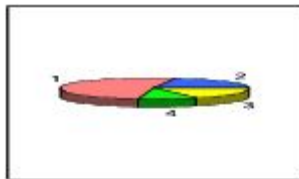
Around 160 local staff and about a dozen overseas volunteers work at the three childcare centers. Chinese staff are employed and trained in a wide range of childcare skills as well as taking on more management responsibility. Small overseas teams are present in the centers for encouragement, advice, interactive training and hands-on involvement in areas of health care, early childhood education, personnel and administration.

Funding

Caring for China is a U.S. 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation. All donations in the U.S. are tax-deductible.

Overseas staff personnel work on a voluntary basis and are provided with accommodation and local transportation by the organization.

Caring for China funds are administered as follows:



- 1 Chinese carers and support staff
- 2 Children's daily necessities
- 3 Utilities, transportation and maintenance of premises
- 4 Administration

These sectors reflect the average monthly expenses and do not include medical treatment or surgery.



Childcare Partnership

The Childcare Partnership Program enables you to help in the support and care of individual children with the provision of :

- a loving and secure environment
- food and clothing
- age appropriate education
- therapy sessions for children with special needs
- domestic transportation
- check-up visits for children in foster homes
