Health for China (HfC) is an exciting new venture of an organisation in China, which also embraces “Teachers for China” (TfC) and “Caring for China’s Children” (CfCC).

Headed up by a Consultant Paediatrician from Australia, HfC is overseen by an international Board of Directors, supported by a world-wide network of supporters and prayer partners.



Working with HfC

The Need

China has many large cities, but the majority of its huge population live in the countryside.

Most of the population is poor and many have very limited access to essential health services. Clinical needs abound for people of all age groups in care centres, hospitals and communities. The provision of health training, preventative health care and community development is particularly important to provide long-term solutions to China’s health challenges.



The Vision

HfC was conceived through a vision we believe God has given - to bring wholeness and healing to a nation where many people hitherto have been denied this opportunity. The heart of the work is to share the Love of Christ, and to be His hands and feet bringing medical aid to some of the many in need.

The Response

HfC integrates three main programmes:

1. Health Training for:
 - Staff of Chinese Child Welfare Centres
 - Medical University Students, including doctors, nurses and primary health-care
2. Health & Medical Consultancy for:
 - Abandoned children in Welfare Centres of Central China operated by CfCC

Training with HfC

- City and rural hospitals and community health services
 - National Chinese and international Staff employed by TfC, CfCC and HfC in China.
3. Community Care for the homeless and drug addicts in NW China. This programme is in a developmental phase.

HfC operates in full co-operation with Chinese Authorities. Progressively, relationships are being built with multiple sectors and organisations including universities, hospitals, health clinics and practitioners, government departments and NGO’s, corporate businesses and local people.
