

The health center has been very busy over the last few months. Here are some of the stories of lives that have been changed. One area of our work that has grown significantly over the last few months is opportunities to meet the needs of those in the local community

“HEAVENLY STRENGTH”

“Heavenly Strength” is a child from an orphanage who has spina bifida. Prior to coming to the Health Center she walked on her anklebone instead of her foot. Her left leg is also numb and so she has had significant

problems with pressure wounds and infections. She has not been able to walk for many months, which is extremely frustrating for an energetic 4 year old.

Over the last few months we have been treating her condition and finally operated to help straighten her foot. She is now able to walk on the sole of her foot. We are thankful to God for the provision of materials and expertise to allow Heavenly Strength to walk and play like other children.



SOLOMON'S TUMOR OPERATION



Solomon was found by a group of caring Christians at the train station in a desperate position. He came to the Health Center in July with a very large protruding eye tumor. We were able to operate and remove the tumor and he spent over four weeks with us in recovery. He has been provided with some temporary housing while he continues to recover

and has been invited to join a Bible study group. Please pray for him to receive Jesus and find complete healing for his body, mind, and spirit.



MR. W'S LEG

Last year Mr. W was brought to the Health Center after falling off a bridge while at work. He was found at the train station about a week after the accident with a severe infection in his lower leg. After great efforts to treat the infection failed, he had to have his lower leg amputated. He had made himself a make shift leg from three rods of steel bound together with some plastic ties and rubber. He was able to return to the Health Center in July to be provided and fitted with a professionally made prosthesis. It is wonderful to be able to see this man have a positive future with hope from Jesus and to be practically provided for by a loving family from around the world who support this work.

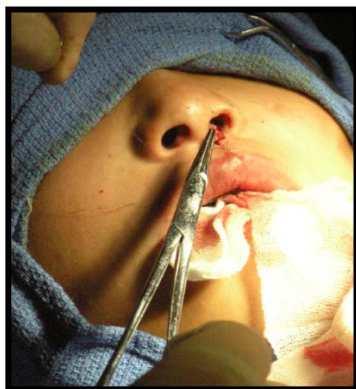
the intensity of care is beyond what the Child Care Centers are able to offer. We have also been visiting these centers for ongoing assessment and treatment of these special children

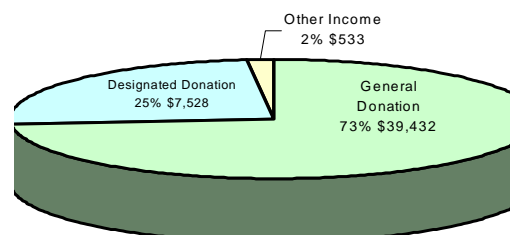
opportunity that would not be available to them without your help. Each time we meet them they express deep gratitude. We pass on their gratitude to you
